

Amateur Affidavit

WDCTA follows the USEF's definition of amateur status per the USEF Rule Book:

Regardless of one's equestrian skills and/or accomplishments, a person is an amateur for all competitions conducted under Federation rules who, after his/her 18th birthday, as defined in GR1306.1, has not engaged in any of the activities which would make him/her a professional.

For information on remuneration that prohibits individuals from amateur status, review GR1306.2-7.

Exceptions/Specifics

- **Traditional Dressage Division:** Individuals are only eligible to compete as amateurs from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach age 22. See DR119.3.
- **Eventing Division:** See EV Appendix 3 — Participation in Horse Trials.
- **Western Dressage Division:** See WD102.3b.

NOTE: Dressage Opportunity classes do not require amateur status. (See GR1307.1.)
